Hill to Kittson

Low water at Goose Rapids and all along Red River. Feels sure there is no danger of a rail road being built on west side of Miss. River. Re Nor. Pac.'s attitude of "bullying their way thro.'" If they do not co-operate, insist at once on Beatty's making the changes & also withdraw our tariff in connection with them, in order to force the Collingwood Line to [---?] Low water troubles on Red River. "Depend on it we will have no more trouble from Moorhead."
