Hill to Sir Wilfred carbon and letterbook

Re the line we are building west of Okanogan River up Semilkameen River to foot of mts. "In order to reach the mouth of that [S] River our surveys have shown our line west of [Nelson?] to the mouth of the Semilkameen River on the south side of the boundary. The cost of a line north of the boundary between these points would be much greater. The ores from that country will reach the smelters at Midway and Grand Forks." Too low grade ore for high transportation rates. Have at present a force on upper end of Sem. Valley and are also building eastward from west end
