Fred Brackett's "Statement of St. Paul, Minneapolis and Manitoba Land Grant, November, 1886"

Special report of Brackett, selecting agent, on unfilled selections, 800,000 acres. "The 230,000 acres above on the Main Line, were selected to make up for deficiencies on the St. Vincent Extension, and to include a claim for 65,000 acres in lieu of that amount of Land in Dakota, within the limits of the Main Line, assuming that the grant in place should be allowed to lap over from Minnesota into the adjoining Territory, which in 1857 was a part of Minnesota."
