Wellington and Fisher contracted for last winter, after long discussion with Mr. Hill and myself. These parties had already been dealing largely in lands on the 'Breckenridge flats.' and the sale in question, about 28,000 acres, embraced all the odd lots, wet and dry good and bad, in the neighborhood of Doran, the adjoining station; the price was \$3.75 per acre, subject to rebate if settled or paid for within a given time."
