In accordance with Hill's instructions, has had a survey made from a connection with the present Great Northern line from Wenatchee up the west side of the Columbia River to Chelan Falls. States that the line down the Columbia would be heavy work. The Northern Pacific road has already located a line from Lake Chelan down the Chelan River and up the Columbia to Virginia and have filed their map in the Land Office. States that a line from Chelan

Falls up to the mouth of the Okanogan
River can be built cheaper than the line
from Wenatchee River to Chelal Falls.
