Minneapolis Street Railway Co.

Organized July 1, 1873.

In 1875 the city council of Minneapolis granted the company the exclusive right to construct and operate a railway line in such streets as the city council deemed suited to street railways.

In 1879 the legislature of Minn. passed an act confirming the above ordinance. On Dec. 9 1890 the new electric road was opened for travel between St. Paul and Minneapolis. The writer of this letter [Lowry] [?] proposes to organize a new line. (continued on next card)
