"The company was first organized as the Lyndale Railway Company under articles dated June 19, 1878, wherein its line was defined as - 'from a point within the city limits of the city of Minneapolis to at or near Lake Calhoun in Hennepin County Minnesota; but by amendment of the articles in Feby. 1881, the name of the corporation was changed to that by which it is now known, and its line was defined as - 'from a point within, or a point near by without, the city limits of the city of Minneapolis; in the state of

Minnesota to at or near Lake Minnetonka  
in said state via Lake Calhoun and  
Lake Harriet in Hennepin County in said  
state, with a branch &c."
