The Minn. Rate case was referred by the U.S. Circuit Court to Judge Olis as Master, has been thoroughly tried and the record is so complete over points that the Supreme Court should have no difficulty in drawing the line between good and bad law. The Master's report will come up before the court in about sixty days, and the case will then, undoubtedly, be appealed to the Supreme Court. I think this is the most important and most thoroughly tried case before it for years.
