I dislike the tone and intimations in Mr. Minot's correspondence with J.Kennedy Tod & Co. Perhaps "what he is all the way through aiming at, is, to protect, and benefit, the Manitoba Co. That is all that you or I and, as far as I know, every one connected with the Manitoba Co. ever intended but much of what Mr Minot says is obscure where it ought to be perfectly clear and it does look as if he intended that a reversionary interest of 7,500 shares of stock, or at least the price at which the Manitoba Co. may call for it within 2 years, should fall to L[ee]H[igginson] & Co. or himself.
