"They have found a very heavy vein of specular ore (30 to 40 feet wide) about 15 miles up Belt Creek from where we changed horses before reaching Great Falls the ~~last~~ day." "When in Montana a few days since I found a number of rumors about 'Sweet Grass Hills' and also saw some samples of copper and silver ore... That country is surely mineral."
