Records of two mining members of a group of associated companies of Montana in which Hill had investments. The mining companies were: the Red Mountain Consolidated Mining Co. and Neihart Mines. Also in the group were: Great Falls Water Power and Townsite Co. (Gt. Falls W. Power & Land Co.) and Montana Central Railway Co., with Sand Coulee Coal Co. probably also included. The mines were in the Belt district, from which the railroad (supplied with coal from Sand Coulee mines) carried ore (gold, silver &c.) to the smelter in Gt. Falls. The investors were special friends of Hill: J. W. Sterling (for Geo. S. [redacted] & Donald Smith), J.

H.P. Upham, H.D. Minot, M. [redacted] Field, Geo. C. Clark
Greenleaf Clark, Amherst Wilder, and Benjamin
