Largely deeds, abstracts of deeds, indentures, statements of receipts and expenditures, and general correspondence covering the activities of agents for sales of North Dakota lands and the purchase, operation, destruction, and sale of remaining equipment &c. of the Grand Pacific Hotel in Moorhead, Minnesota, on the Red River of the North. Much of the land correspondence as with Wells & Dickey of Jamestown, N.D., Hill's agents. After Hill's death, the properties were turned over by his heirs to the Norman Land Co. C. Healion until the 1890's and thereafter

in his St. Paul office [REDACTED] Moorhead David Mc -
Cay and John Dahlquist were agents.
