Sends comparative statements for Eastern of Minnesota compared with Eastern railroads. "We are doing still better on the Eastern this yr. and hope next year to considerably reduce the ton mile cost. The Eastern is being operated entirely by a young man of 27 years with only three and a half years since he was graduated from Yale College. Re Barr, now v.p. of Norfolk & Western, formerly our Gen. Supt. who came to us from the St. Paul [Milwaukee Road] as Div. Supt. at \$250 per month and after 2½ years left us for his present position at \$15,000 per yr.. Re Winter, Geo. B.
