For some reason Hill would not donate money to Morman colleges. In this letter he states: "What I am doing is limited to denominational colleges in an effort to place a number of such, situated in the newly settled Northwest, upon a permanent basis through a permanent endowment fund for each, the income only from which goes to the general fund of the institution. Before this can be done they should be substantially out of debt. My work tends to all denominations except Mormans." (see back of card)
