

Nebraska Lines

February 7, 1901

Rev. H. Borchart to J. J. Hill.

"During the year the former Sioux City and Northern and the Pacific short line, in Nebraska, have been purchased by the Great Northern system, and during the summer thousands of men have been employed to thoroughly overhaul the road on the Wilmer [sic] divisions and other lines. This now gives us another direct route from Sioux City to St. Paul and Minneapolis, without being compelled to change cars, as we had to do formerly... The management is very helpful to emigrants

and settlers of new countries. The equipment of engines and cars stands equal to the very best in the land."
