Knute Nelson to James J. Hill.

States that he cannot agree with Hill on the proposed reciprocity with Canada. Has been studying this matter carefully and especially from the viewpoint of the farmers of Minnesota. Believes that "their interests and their welfare ought not to be sacrificed as it appears they are being in the proposed reciprocity agreement," and that Hill will not blame him "for looking at it from the standpoint of the farmer, as well as from the standpoint of the railroads, millers and

jobbers."
