Knute Nelson to J. J. Hill.

Is extremely disappointed over the President's veto of the right-of-way bill over Indian reservations in Montana, and also that a Tennessee man has been appointed Commissioner to negotiate with the Minnesota Indians. States that "on the whole we are in the hands of the Philistines," and that "a Democratic administration is not as kind to our Northwest as were our Republican administrations -- we are evidently regarded of no consequence."
