"Though not as good as most of the coals of the Alleghany and Illinois coal fields the Sand Coulee coal will compare favorably with the carboniferous coal of Iowa or the more modern coals on the line of the Union Pacific Railroad or the coal of Boseman and that of the Puget Sound region, while it lies more favorably for cheap and easy working than any of those mentioned."
