

Nichols, Edward Tatnall

Born in 1853.

From February, 1876 to 1882 he was specially employed by J.S.Kennedy "to assist in the business they were transacting for the Dutch bond holders of the St. Paul & Pacific bonds - the First Division and extensions."

Nichols was one of the witnesses to the signing by Stephen, Smith, Hill and Kittson of the agreement on March 13, 1878 between the four above mentioned men and the

Committee of Dutch bondholders and the First Division of the St. Paul and Pacific R.R. Co.

In 1888 Nichols was assistant treasurer of the St. Paul, Minneapolis and Manitoba Railway Company.
