Telegram. J.J.Hill to E.T.Nichols.

Mohler has arrived [in St. Paul] and clearly understands the situation. Further information must not be given to Coster, now that [Nor. Pacific] crews are surveying the south branch of the Clearwater [River]. Mohler must be heartily supported as he as conservative and "hesitates in applying heroic measures which in the end will be much cheaper." States that there can be no division of territory south of the Clearwater.
