Papers of this company, consisting mainly of statements of receipts and disbursements cover the years 1881-1894. Also included are the articles of incorporation, estimates, proxies, memos, comparative statements of various years, but very little correspondence.

There were actually two different companies formed:-the first in May, 1881. The capital stock was to be \$25,000 and there were incorporators from fourteen different counties in Minnesota See articles of incorporation, April 1, 1881). A new company

was formed Dec. 30, 1006 stock was issued January 31, 1887 for 5,000. This company printed the paper, "Nordvesten."

Also included in the papers is a hard-covered book, "Stock Ledger & Register of Transfers of 'Nordvesten Publishing House.'" However, this book contains only three pages of stock transfers. There are two boxes of these papers.
