3 volumes: 1886-88; 1888 - 1889; and 1909-10.

Bills; board furnished at Boarding house (by names of boarders, dates, &c.); lists of workmen with their salaries or wages; farm improvements; butter record; butter disposal; animals slaughtered; supplies to boarding house; expenses of teamsters; occupations of men on the farm; supplies from the farm delivered to Hill's residence (butter, cream, mutton, poultry, vegetables, eggs, potatoes, etc.); work done by employees by the day (cutting cordwood, brushing pastures and other areas, hauling hay, "in cow barn"; grading, pulling and hauling stumps,

fixing fences, tearing down horsebarn, running engine, moving house, setting glass in greenhouse and vineries, fixing calf barn, disposal of meat after slaughtering; making hay; carpenter work; gardening; elk and deer account; carriage house expenses; dogs; milk sold and to whom; "hauling mud &c from Ditch in Lake"; supplies used at boarding house; firewood sold and used on farm; garden produce raised and its money value; etc.
