Statutes of Minn. and Wis. provide that no official of a Railway Company shall hold office in a parallel or competing Co. and Directors are officers. "The law is apparently quite clear ... and would prevent Schiff, Stillman, Harriman, and probably William Rockefeller from holding position or director in either Great Northern or Northern Pacific." Mellen is still acting as if there was no common interest between our Companies.
