This letter gives a great deal of information on the operation of the Northern Pacific Road from January to June, 1898. It mentions abandoning 8 locomotives for heavier ones, so that the company can now haul long train loads and so operate with greater economy. The shops at Mandan and at Fargo have been abolished, as has the narrow gauge line between Wallace & Mission. Dividends are also discussed.
