Re draft of agreement with Northern Pacific -  
great detail and outline of policy for joint  
use of some railroad branches. "This agreement  
is of the very greatest importance to us as it  
fixes forever the value of our Branch line and  
to a great extent the value of our Extension  
Line north of Glyndon." "Under no circumstance  
whatever would it be fair or equitable for us  
to let their Duluth traffic go north of Glyndon  
on a pro rata basis."
