Hill, Dr. Nathan B. (Father of Samuel Hill).

"(A prominent and enlightened physician) moved with his family from North Carolina to Minneapolis (by way of Indiana) at the outbreak of the Civil War, while Sam was still a small boy... His father was active in the legislature and in social and civic work... and was also President of the State Medical Association. He died when Sam was nine."
