Hill to Mark Hanna, Chicago

Thinks Minnesota will give a majority of 15 to 25,000 for McKinley, but there has been no precinct canvass as promised by Committee & so this is really guesswork. Details of his own financial support to McKinley: \$20,000 to the Hard Money Democratic campaign; \$10,000 into Congressional work and will put \$2,000 more there also; \$5,000 to Hard Money Dem. in Washington D.C. and have told them if another \$5,000 will insure the results to write for it. In addition I have put \$30,000 into the hands of the state campaign, 1 being used for the

Republican ticket in Minnesota.
