In it are the following:

1 folder marked: "Real estate deeds & abstracts

1864-1883"
1 folder marked "Real estate, St. Paul, 1898"

1 folder marked "1111 Summit Avenue" (Walter Hill's temporary home after marriage)

2 folders, 1892-1908, marked, "King Property."

These relate to the property of a Minneapolis man of prominence, William S. King, who, like Hill, was interested in raising blooded stock. His extensive holdings of land in Minneapolis eventually became the property of Lowry (his.) and Hill.
