Louis W. Hill to Jas. J. Hill (in London)

Is sending copy of Judge Burke's letter regarding franchise for new railroad through Seattle. Col. Clough thinks the N.P. hopes to get additional trackage rights for the Seattle & International Road.

Has wired Stevens to go at once to Seattle. Farrington & Newman have conferred on the Buffalo Elevator Pool. Louis Hill had suggested to Farrington that he "keep clear of the pool entirely" and meet J.J.Hill in

New York "to find out just what your policy will be in regard to the first season of the Buffalo house."

Daly has gone East for 2 or 3 weeks and "was much disturbed over your letter."

Has been corresponding with Prince Albert [of Belgium] aid-de-Camp.
