Hill to J.J.Hill in London

"At last B. F. Nelson syndicate have bought the Pillsbury and Walker pine - also Ackeley's - papers are now being drawn. This will in 15 years give Pillsbury \$3,000,000 and Walker \$4,000,000 .... They plan to move the mill to Leech Lake and haul over the G.N.Ry" Re local politics (George L. Becker, Doran, Washburn, Donnelly). "Donnelly ... will move his paper to Minneapolis. The question as to whether he and Owen can run rival papers and live in the same town may arise....Owen will if Donnelly supports him defeat Nel 1.... Donnelly is a

candidate for U.S. Senator and D.M.Sabin is  
one also. It is thought the latter is in  
Nelson's interest."
