

Hill, Samuel

Born May 13, 1857 at Deep River, North Carolina; g. Haverford College, 1878 (A.B.); got another A/B. at Harvard in 1879; and his LLD at Penn. Admitted to the bar in 1880. Was attorney for the M& St. L. rr 1880-88.

Married Mary Hill, dau. of JJH and MTH in 1888. Died in Portland, Oregon, Feb. 26, 1931. See further data in Mrs. Gavin's scrapbook.

See Accession number 39 which is a verifax copy of a letter from Richard H. Hendricks, an member of Friends Memorial [Quaker] Church, located at 7740 24th Ave. N.E., Seattle, Washington. The letter, dated October 27, 1964 refers to Samuel Hill son-in-law of James J. Hill, and to two other men whose contributions of money made the church possible. The church was built as a memorial to the fathers of the three men.
