

Hill, Saunders and Acker (firm of)

On May 1, 1875, Edward N. Saunders, J.J. Hill, George S. Acker and John A. Armstrong became co-partners in a general merchandizing business.

On May 1, 1878 the partnership of Hill, Saunders and Acker expired by limitation and was finally and formally dissolved. [See, copy of J.J.Hill's letter to Union Chemical Co., Oct. 31, 1878, Letterbook].

After this, for a short time, Saunders and Acker carried on an independent business in salt and cement, but shortly
