

O'Connor, Honora ("Nora" or Mrs. Peter)

lived in St. Anthony Falls [1860's][?], where her husband, Peter, had a general trading store. It is possible that Honora (Nora) O'Connor "guided Mrs. Hill socially and otherwise, and took her under her wing when the Hills were first married."
