

Pacific Extension - Exploration      June 22, 1890

Copy of a letter from Beckler to Hill from Fairhaven, Washington, discussing possible lines to the Coast through the Cascades and from Seattle to New Westminster (Fairhaven & Southern), with mention of many rivers, passes, &c.: Wenatchee, Methow, Suiattle [wrongly copied as "Snattle" in letterbook], Sauk, Stilaquamish, and Crab rivers; Lake Chelan; and Snoqualmie, Stampede, Indian, and Cady passes; etc. Best pass not found yet. Ellensburg is also mentioned.
