"Henry Higginson confirms what Roberts told me about a Vanderbilt plan to get control--that is I assume that it is Vanderbilt--Henry says somebody with ample means--I feel so well convinced of the value of Great Northern since my trip with you that I shall urge on [our?] friends to take all they can pay for so as to stand with you and keep the control where it is--H. thinks I ought to go East & I may leave for Boston tomorrow--If so I shall expect to return at once--"
