Pettigrew to Hill

"In pursuance of the intimation made by you in regard to building a road from Huron down to the Missouri River near Wheeler, and thus connect with the line at Yankton, my brother and others have organized a company in South Dakota called the 'Dakota Southern Railroad Company' covering this road, and I have introduced a bill granting right of way to the company over the Yankton Indian allotted lands in Charles Mix County; also a bill to authorize the construction of a bridge across the Missouri River at Yankton,

the charter to run to the same Company, for the reason that Mr. Naon who pretended to represent an English Syndicate secured a majority of the stock of the old company, and has run away with it."

Asks Hill to furnish money for the survey.
