Pettigrew to JJH, General Correspondence

"I wish to...ask you to assist John Wilson in securing his election to the United States Senate from Washington. You will find him a friend and I know he is a straight forward fellow. It would pay you I think to take a little pains [sic] to see that your friends out there support him. I will guarantee he is all right. I hope you will assist Senator Powers [sic] in Montana. I should like also to have you send an annual pass to Hartman Member of Congress from Montana. He has been your fighting friend and helped me in the contest over the Great Falls Townsite matter...."
