"I think there is no doubt but that our Mill deal has been closed, but the C.C. Washburn mills are out of the deal. I understand that Gov. Pillsbury is to sign the contracts Monday.; [sic] that the underwriting has all been secured, and that it will be offered to the public within the next two weeks. I think it best the thing whould be kept still. I have hard [sic] of it two or three times, coming from New York. Of course the newspapers are likely to get on to it at any moment, but I shall not give them any information at present."
