Discusses his duties as follows: "In addition to my regular duties I am now engaged in exacmining the titles to the Company's [Great Northern Road] lands. saving some pieces that were as good as lost, tracing defects in others and devising means to perfect the titles. This is not clerical work, it requires a thorough knowledge of title and tax matters and has heretofore been attent [sic] to by the Company's attorney."
