Septmeber 24,1877 Proctor, John W. Hill to Supt., House of Correction, Detroit, Mich. Encloses letter to Proctor and a quit claim deed for him to sign and return - also ten dollars. I learn from Mayor McLane [McLean?] of Bismarck that Proctor's suit comes up this week and unless it is disposed of before, judgment will be given against him [in divorce suit] because no one has put in any answer for him and the case goes by default.
