JJH to J. S. Kennedy, July 22, 1887

Line from Hinckley to Superior should be built and ready for fall business of 1888. Chief engineer returned today "from a tramp over the proposed line." Thinks it best to have a separate company for this line. Cost will be about \$1,000,000 with \$500,000 more for elevators & terminals, with \$1,000,000 for equipment; then sell the property of our Lake Superior and Southwestern for \$3,000,000 of the new co.'s stock. Re vast Boston investment in Hill's rr. line ("between \$5 and 6,000,000 of our stock.")
