C.M.Ramsay, of Brechin, Forfarshire, Scotland was owner of Stephen Farm in northern Minnesota. The manager of the farm was J. Gillespie. There is a good deal of correspondence, during these dates, between Ramsay, Toomey and Gillespie concerning a loan of \$17.500 which Hill made to Ramsey, and for which Ramsay gave Hill a demand note on November 27, 1891.

In 1898 Ramsay had repaid very little of the loan, so Hill brought suit against Ramsay and obtained judgment linst him on Dec. 24, 1898 for \$17,010.91 Half obtained liens

against certain portio of Stephen farm in Marshall and Polk countes, and this land was to be sold. However, Ramsay finally re-paid Hill and the sale of the land was cancelled. See carbon of letter from Toomey to A.C.Wilkinson, June 21, 1899.
