Encloses translation by Klein of letter to some Dutch newspaper [Financier ?], an item in behalf of Sahlgaard's suit. He left the 2nd for Holland and is working through a Rotterdam firm of express and commission men named Ittmans [?] and Co. Gilman seems to think the Extension bonds of Lippman, Rosenthal & Co. should not participate in the proceeds of the sale of the property. Better advise LR & Co. of all this. Re good harvest in Red River Valley and bridging the river with a trestle bridge

until permanent one can be built.
