

St. Anthony Falls Water Power Co. 1856-1903

Papers of this company contain data on the following: incorporation, Feb. 26, 1856; incorporators, Franklin Steele, Richard Chute, John S. Prince, among others; Pillsbury-Washburn Flour ^{mills} Company, Ltd., London (bought the stock in 1889); J. T. Fanning, chief engineer of the co.; the town of St. Anthony, especially its real estate; *ibid* for Minneapolis; Minneapolis real estate and water supply; Hennepin Island; Boom Island; Boom Landing; Nicollet Island; Frederick Butterfield, owner for a time of all the seven sawmill sites later acquired by Hill, Stepher Angus, Smith, and

Kennedy for \$400,000, April 15, 1880; water power of the Mississippi River; St. Anthony Falls history from 1856 to 1903 or thereabout as supplied by lawsuit briefs and other records: some printed, others manuscript; flour milling in Minneapolis and Minnesota; and sawmilling in Minneapolis and Minnesota.
