Re reasons for settling the lawsuit of the St. Anthony Water Power Co., decided against that co. and for Farnham & Lovejoy in the lower courts and appealed to the Supreme Court of U.S before we bought the company. Now the matter of building our bridge makes it necessary for us to use a strip of Farnham & Lovejoy's land. So I have bought the property for the Water Power Co. at \$112,500. "This gives our ...co. fully three fifths of the power at the Falls & is worth to us fully the price first asked by them \$150,000 outside (the Right of Way...
