Trott and Knuppe are still there & it will be best to keep them until McKinley gets all old matters closed up. By Aug. he hopes to do so; checking of agents along rr line shows much looseness. Fears Northern Pacific is planning to build from Casselton to boundary near Turtle Mountain.
