Hill to J.S. Kennedy All roads are blocked with snow. We should extend the Grand Forks line to the Boundary and the Canadian Pacific should at once survey and grade a line from Winnipeg to the boundary; it will pay from the start, being through the very best part of Manitoba. Porter and I have wired Merrill to come at the earliest date "to fix up the St. Paul and Duluth." Porter is anxious to have it closed. As president he is called on to do many things that take more time than he can spare.
