Stickney, P.H.Kelly and others from St. Paul are in Miles City, Montana Territory "in the interest of establishing large slaughtering & packing houses at St. Paul in conjunction with the cattle growers Association of Montana. A delegation has been appointed by the Association to confer with the St. Paul people & it is understood they go there at an early date. It is thought here that West St. Paul is Mr. Stickney's Point."
