Jacob Schiff to James J. Hill.

Has received Hill's telegram, and has seen Leonard Lewisohn, who remarked, "that he, personally had made great efforts to conciliate the conflicting interests between the B. & A. and Anaconda Companies, but that Mr. Haggin had not met his overtures in the same spirit."

Lewisohn also stated that "in his personal opinion, the Anaconda people, while they might be ready with promises to gain your support at this time, had no intention of opening works at Great Falls, as their interests at Anaconda

town were already too great to permit them to do this."
