


Seattle - Settlers

O.H.McGill to Hill

"Ten thousand people are said to have moved into the Queen Anne Hill district, largely laboring men, including very generally the Smith's Cove employees, induced here by cheap lots and installment payments. We are building a church directly east of the docks, former 5th West and Garfield, planned for institutional work... whole ships crews have attended our services in a body. We have a Japanese night school, started by our people."
